

At Dragon's Gate

These giant gold Koi are yin and yang, the dark overhead and the emerging Koi, is the light leaping towards the viewer.

According to Chinese Mythology, the dragon's gate is located at the top of the waterfall cascading from a legendary mountain. The Chinese proverb tells of the perseverance of the Koi that makes it to the top only to leap off of the waterfall and turn into a dragon. The image of the Koi jumping over the dragon's gate is an old endearing Chinese cultural symbol for courage, preservice, and accomplishment.

The pink Easter Lily Cactus is a symbol of Christianity and renewed life.

The small shell on the left represents Mary, the Mother of Jesus. The one who holds the Pearl of Great Price.

These images are bathed in 23k gold leaf (original artwork) giving them an iconic feel.
