

The Jewel and the Red Square

This majestic jellyfish's elegant tentacles morph into swirls that create rhythmic beauty. It is a sea life fantasy contained in a very design oriented and organized space. I found it aesthetically pleasing to divide the background in 1/3rd and 2/3rd segments by using white gold leaf (original only) and indigo blue colored pencil. As the viewer's eyes follow the swirls, they inevitably rest on the red square (and then back to the swirls in a back and forth motion). The jellyfish symbol of love, acceptance and balance. It is also a symbol of faith, intuition and sensitivity which of these symbol's do you identify?

The interior of the red square represents a Higher Power.

The square represents how we perceive or try to understand the Creator. We box God into our world with its rigid corners limiting relationship, love and mercy. We try to make sense of life's mysteries and the mystery of God in the universe itself.
