

Sister Bernice Gall was born in Howells, Nebraska to Mary (Kluthe) and Joseph Gall. Sister Bernice had five brothers: Edward, Dennis, Leander, Leroy, and Joseph. She has three sisters: Alice Masters, Benilda Spinner, and Marie Koley.

Sister Bernice was received as a School Sister of St. Francis, June 13, 1956, profession of first vows June 21, 1958 and made final profession on June 20, 1964. She received a BS in Education in 1970 and MS in Education in 1976.
